They improve your experience by remembering site related settings and information in addition to measuring how you use the website so we can make sure it meets your needs.

Types of cookies and how we use them:

First party cookies

First party cookies are our own. We control them and use them to provide information about the way you use our website.

a11y-high-contrast

Used to specify a higher contrast colour scheme to aid people with sight difficulties.

a11y-larger-fontsize

Used to specify larger fonts throughout the site to aid people with sight difficulties.

Third party cookies

Third party cookies are set by other websites. We use their online tools to make our website work better for you.

We use Google Analytics to view statistics on the way you use our website. We can check:

- how many people have visited our website and what content they look at.
- how many times documents have been downloaded.
- what people are looking for on our website.

We use the following third party cookies set by Google Analytics.

_ga

Used to distinguish users and expires after two years.

_gid

Used to distinguish users and expires after 24 hours.

_gat

Used to affect the speed of data transfer and expires after one minute.
